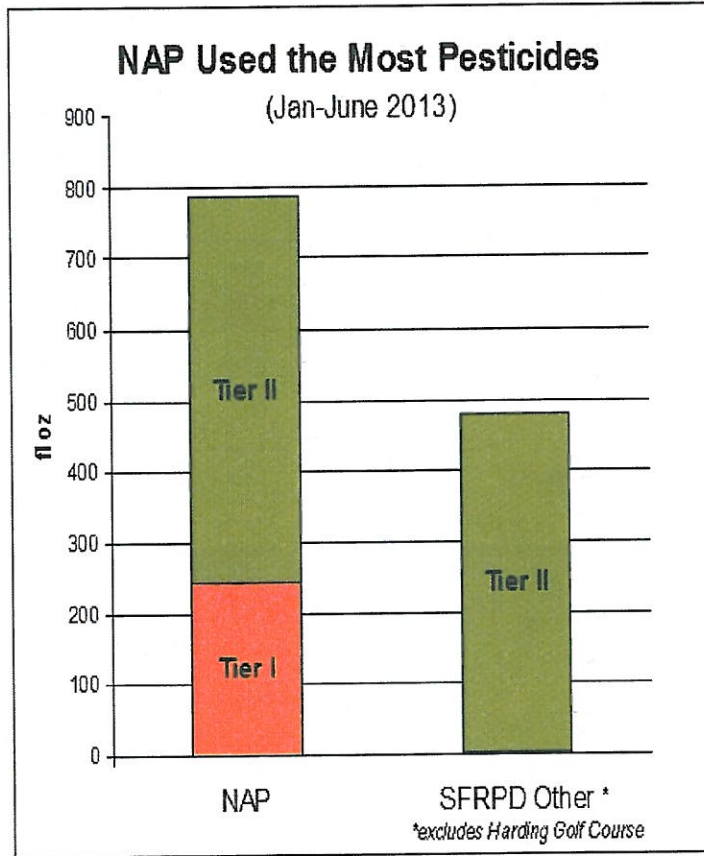


NAP uses more herbicides than the rest of SFRPD combined!

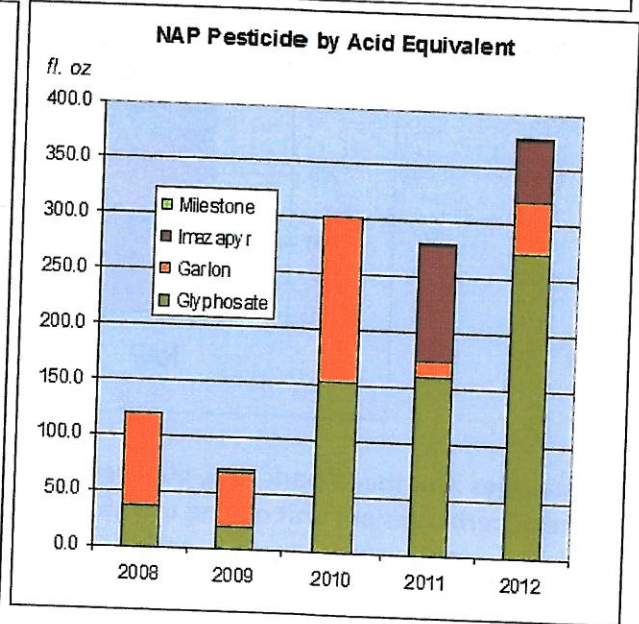
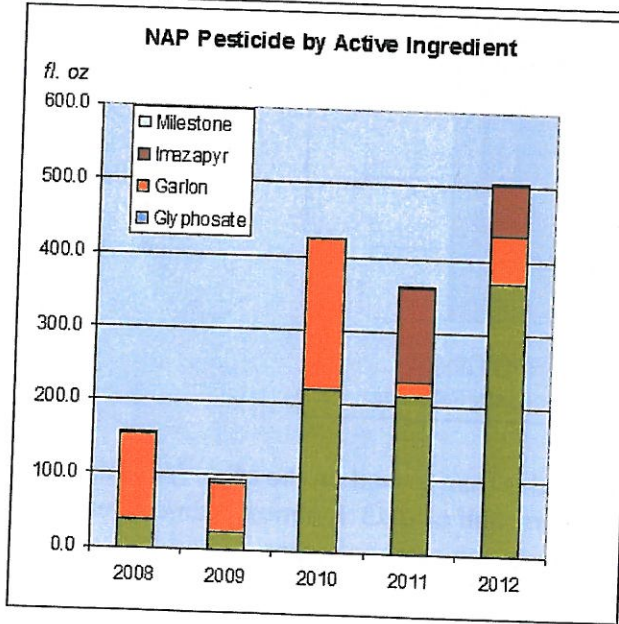
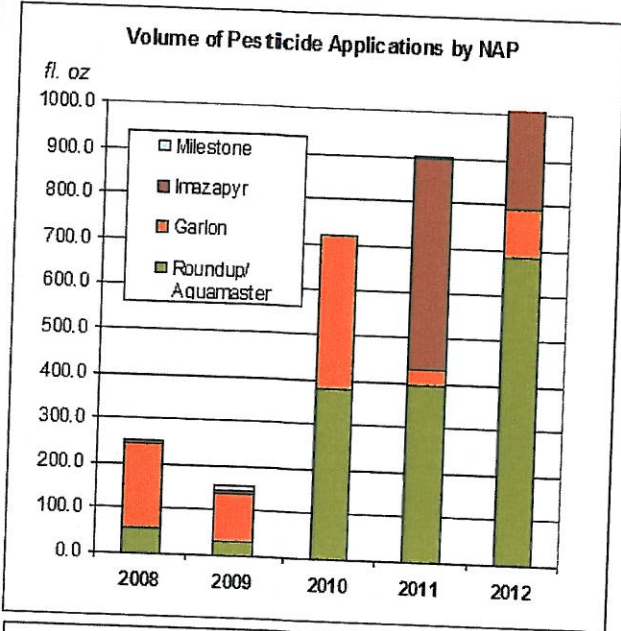
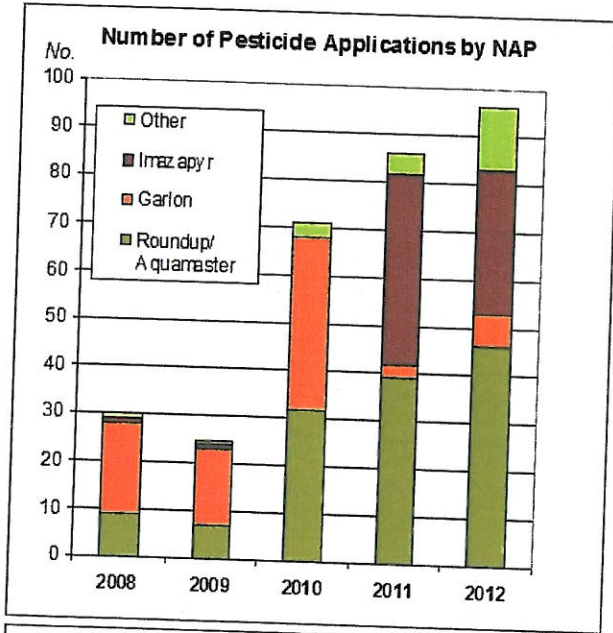


NAP manages $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SF park land, but uses more herbicides than is used on the other $\frac{3}{4}$ of the land: volume of herbicides per unit of land used by NAP in the first half of 2013 is almost 5 times greater than volume of herbicides per unit of land used by the rest of RPD ($790 \times 3 \div 480$).

The OTHER category includes all city golf courses except Harding.

NAP USES MORE AND MORE HERBICIDES!



These herbicides are epidemiologically linked to prostate, non-Hodgkin lymphoma, leukemia, multiple myeloma, and breast cancer.

Milestone (Amino-pyralid) is banned in New York State.

Imazapyr is banned in Europe since 2007 (in Norway since 2001).
