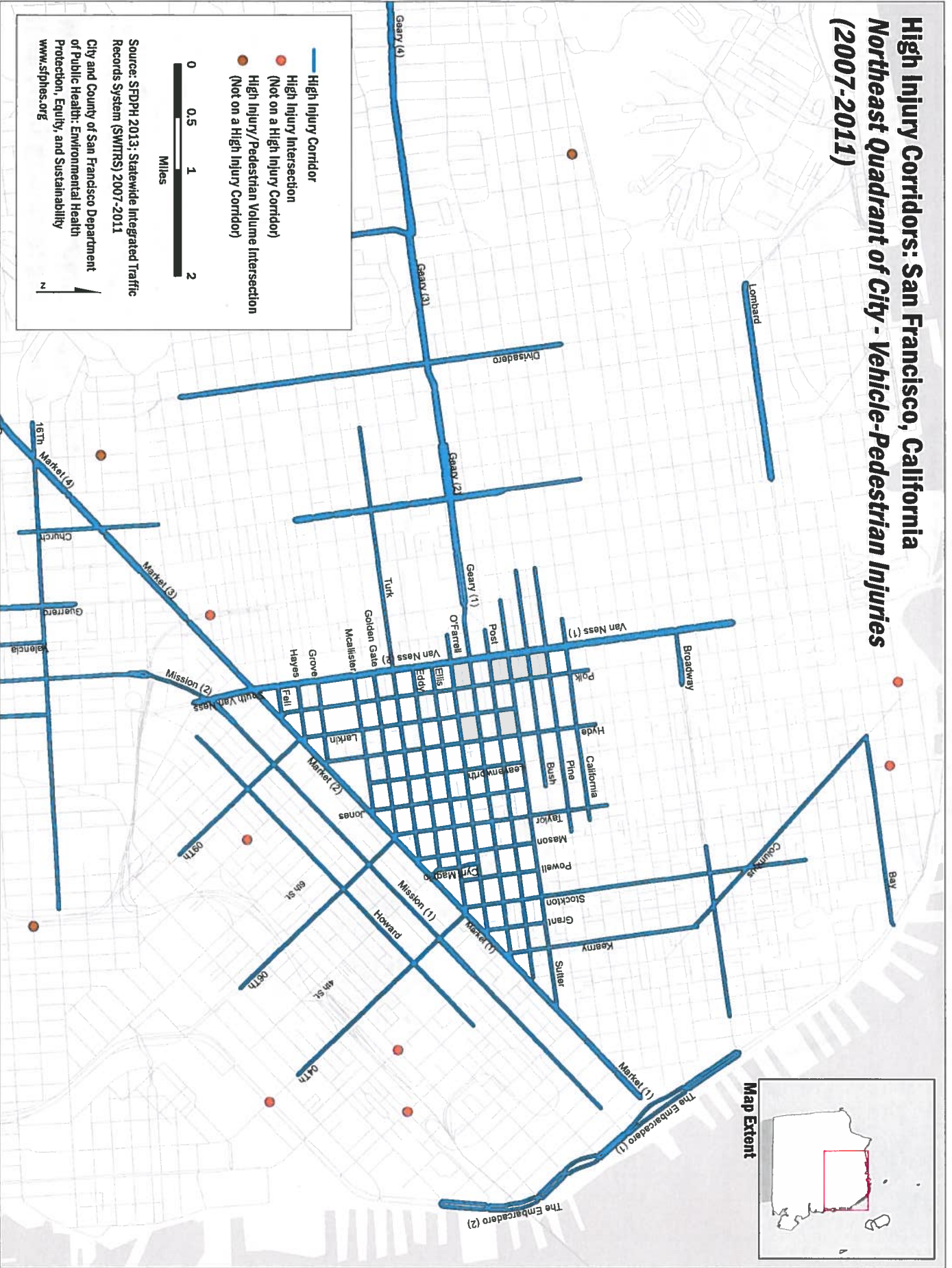


High Injury Corridors: San Francisco, California Northeast Quadrant of City - Vehicle-Pedestrian Injuries (2007-2011)

High Injury Corridors: San Francisco, California Vehicle-Pedestrian Injuries (2007-2011)

High Injury Corridors represent 6% (69 miles) of San Francisco's street miles, where 60% of severe and fatal vehicle-pedestrian injuries occurred in 2007-2011.
