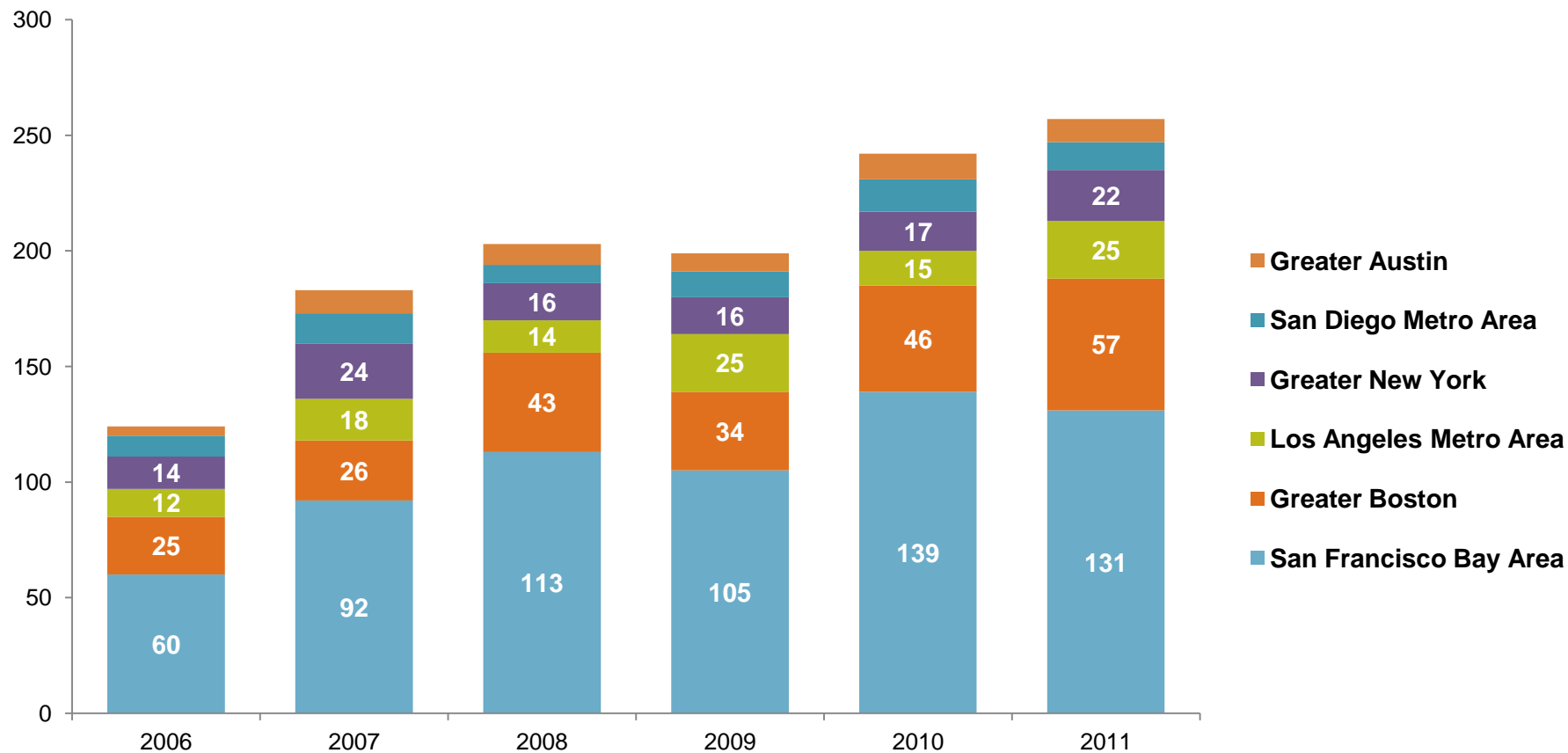

Most Active Cities by Deal Count

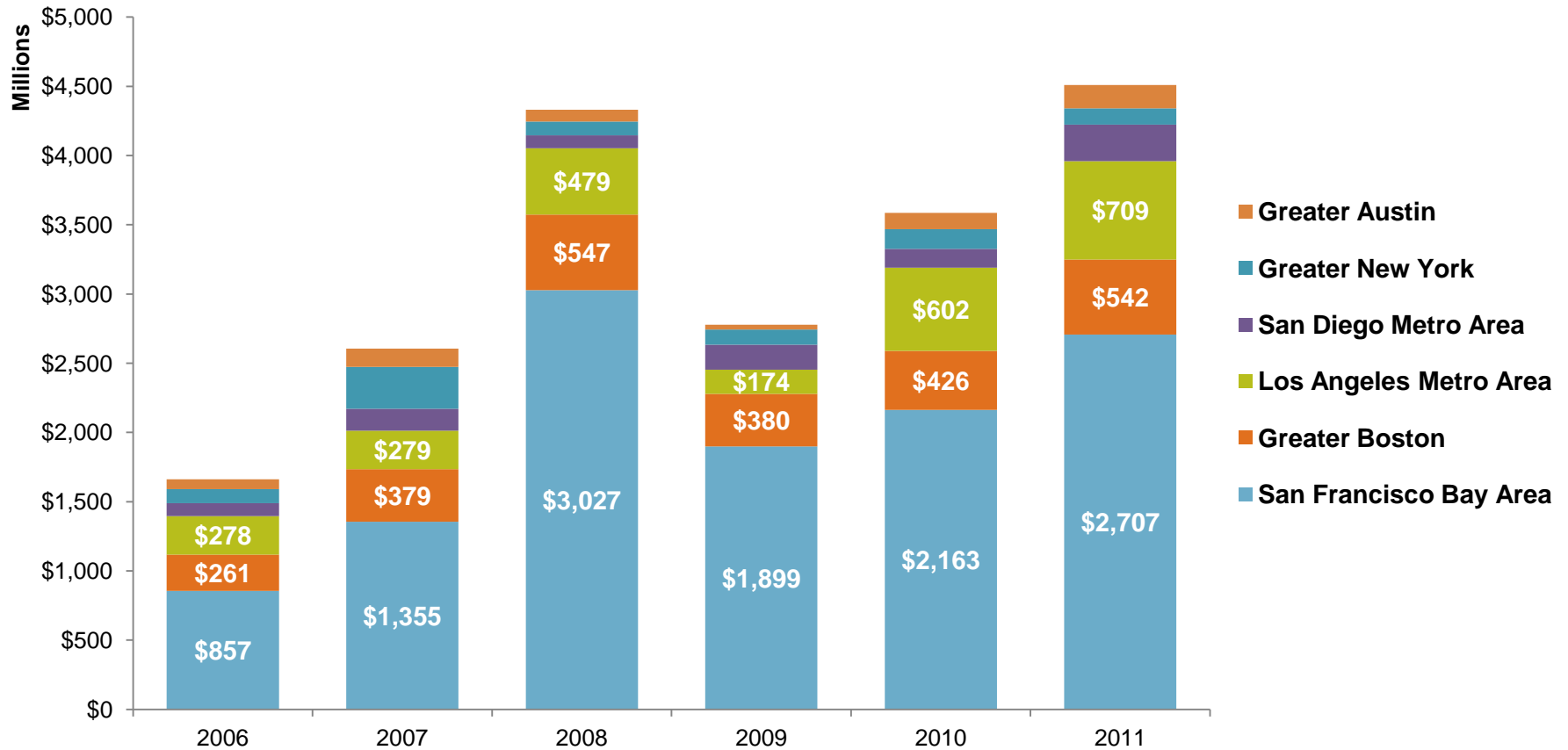
Number of Cleantech Venture Deals by Metro Area

San Francisco: A Cleantech Hub

San Francisco is the home of **208 cleantech companies and investors** - one the largest and most concentrated cleantech clusters in the world.

- **119 active cleantech companies**, most notable include: SunRun, Nexant, ECOtality, SCleenergy, Project Frog, and RelayRides
- **89 active cleantech investors**, most notable include: Nth Power, CMEA, Crosslink Capital, Expansion Capital, DBL Investors...

The Global Cleantech 100 is an annual listing of the top 100 privately held cleantech companies around the world. 58 of the 2011 Global Cleantech 100 companies were located in the United States, and 36 of those in California.
