1. Call to Order and Roll Call.

The meeting was called to order at 5:01 p.m.

Present: Commissioners Mike Sullivan and Johanna Wald.
Excused: Commissioner Elmy Bermejo.

2. Approval of minutes of the September 12, 2022, Commission on the Environment Policy Committee meeting. (Explanatory Document: September 12, 2022, Meeting Draft Minutes) (Discussion and Action)

There was no public comment.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Wald and a second by Commissioner Sullivan, the resolution was approved without objection. (Ayes: Commissioners Wald and Sullivan; Noes: None; Absent: Commissioner Bermejo)

3. General Public Comment. Members of the public may address the Committee on matters that are within the Committee's jurisdiction and are not on today's agenda.

4. Director's Update. Speaker: Tyrone Jue, Acting Director. (Discussion)

Acting Director Tyrone Jue provided updates on the prohibition on gas-powered landscape equipment; changes to Chapter 7 of the Environment Code; an event to recognize climate champions; and an event sponsored by the Pacific Coast Collaborative.

There was no public comment.

5. **Update on Construction and Demolition (C&D) Ordinance Implementation.** Speaker: James Slattery, C&D Zero Waste Senior Coordinator. (Discussion)

James Slattery presented on the Updated Construction and Demolition Debris Recovery Law.

Commissioner Wald and James discussed the fees described in the presentation and the challenges presented by illegal dumping.

Commissioner Sullivan and James discussed elements of the material recovery process.

There was no public comment.

6. **Update on Fix Lead SF Program.** Speakers: Ryan Ramos, Senior Environmental Specialist, and Karen Yu, Senior Environmental Health Inspector, Department of Public Health. (Discussion)

Ryan Ramos and Karen Yu presented on the hazards of lead exposure in homes and the goals of the Fix Lead SF program.

Commissioner Wald and Ryan discussed the program's focus on properties that have received citations from the Department of Public Health.

Commissioner Sullivan, Ryan, and Karen discussed the program's funding sources and the various entities involved in the initiative.

Public Comment: David Pilpel expressed support for the Fix Lead SF program and expressed concerns related to enforcement of the Construction and Demolition Ordinance.

7. **New Business/Future Agenda Items.** Speaker: Kyle Wehner, Commission Affairs Officer. (Discussion)

Kyle Wehner discussed the schedule of future meetings and potential agenda items.

Public Comment: David Pilpel discussed recommendations for a presentation on SB 1383.
