**Board of Supervisors Legislative Activity of Note** (As reported by the Department of the Environment Communications and Policy Director):

Week of October 31, 2016

**Land Use (Monday, October 31, 1:30PM)**

- Ordinance repealing the 2013 Green Building Code in its entirety and enacting a 2016 Green Building Code consisting of the 2016 California Green Building Standards Code as amended by San Francisco; adopting environmental findings and findings of local conditions under the California Health and Safety Code; providing for an operative date of January 1, 2017; and directing the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to forward the legislation to the California Building Standards Commission as required by State law. (Building Inspection Commission)
