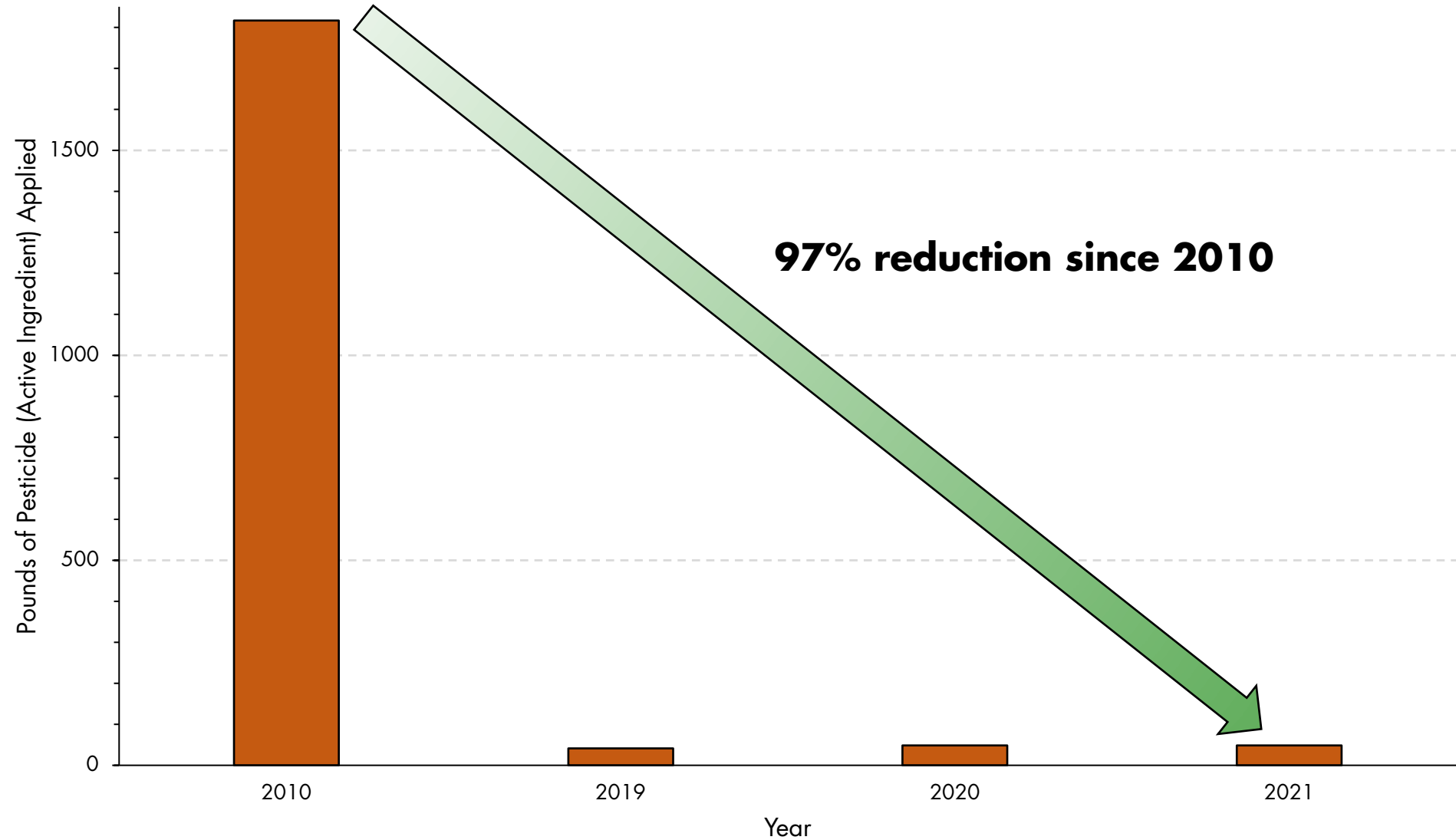

Key Accomplishments from 2021



1. Reduced Tier I herbicide use by 97.4% from 2010–2021
2. Completed pest inspections, interviews, and data analysis on 1,200 affordable housing units in collaboration with Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development
3. Implemented new RFP for Citywide pest management services in collaboration with Office of Contracts Administration
4. Convened monthly virtual IPM Technical Advisory Committee meetings

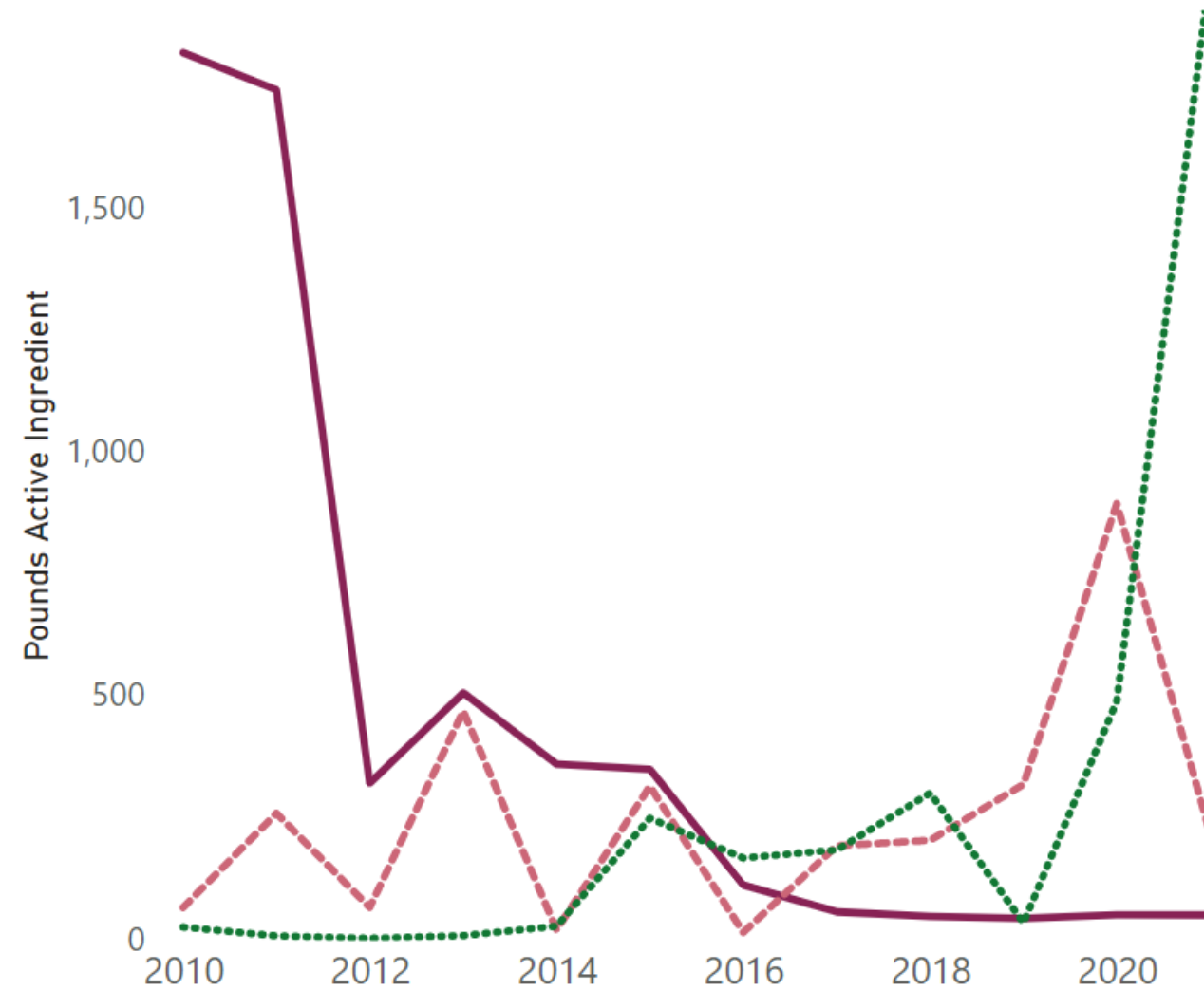
Citywide: Tier I Pesticide Use Trend

Hazard Tier — I Most hazardous - - - II More hazardous III Least hazardous

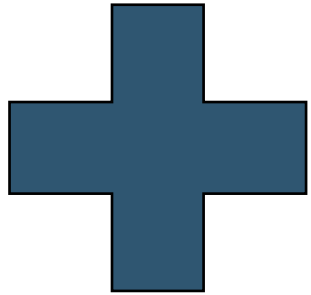


Planned Activities in 2022–2023



1. Explore opportunities for defined funding sources
2. Begin discussions on improved collaborations for vector control efforts with DPH and other City departments
3. Conduct toxicological reviews of pesticides used on municipal properties
4. Transition from virtual to hybrid IPM Technical Advisory Committee meetings
5. Begin updating IPM website

Summary of Proposed RRPL Changes



ADDED one Tier II product
(fungicide with limited use on high-value trees)



REMOVED two Tier II products
(tree growth regulator, rodent bait)

Summary of Proposed RRPL Changes



- Updated language for eight products
- Includes new use limitation language for Garlon 4 Ultra:

“USE UP EXISTING STOCKS to phase out use over next year”
