Containers 15 pharmacies, 5 law enforcement 20 x \$1000 per container	\$20,000
Disposal 18 months, 2000 lb per month 18 x 2000 x ~\$1.50 per lb	\$55,000
Public Outreach \$50,000 per year	\$75,000
Total	\$150,000

Proposed Metrics:

Objective 1: Prevent Poisonings & Abuse

Metric: Obtain data from Police Department and Poison Control and look for decline over the course of the program

Objective 2: Environmental Pollution Prevention

Metric: PUC identifies several key compounds. Look for any discernable difference in effluent?

Objective 3: Convenience for the public

Metric: Volume collected over one year, compared to previous collection programs in SF
