**By submitting this application, the applicant agrees:** (Applies only to construction and demolition debris from San Francisco):

- To not transport any construction and demolition debris from the City and County of San Francisco to any landfill.
- To transport mixed construction and demolition debris ONLY to a processing facility registered by the City and County of San Francisco.
- To provide the registered processing facility the job/building permit number (if applicable) and/or information identifying the source of the construction and/or demolition debris (such as the site address) for each load delivered.



- That the vehicle(s) and each vehicle operator has all necessary permits, authorizations and/or licenses required by any local, state or federal agency and all necessary insurance to operate vehicle(s).
- That each operator has no outstanding notices of violation from any federal, state, or local agency that could affect permits, authorizations or licenses required for continued operation.
- That the vehicle owner is responsible for compliance by any operator(s) of any vehicle(s) covered by this application.
- To keep a copy of Transporter Registration in each vehicle that transports construction and demolition debris.
- To renew this registration every two (2) years.

***Definition of Construction and Demolition Debris***

“Construction and Demolition Debris” shall mean building materials and solid waste generated from construction and demolition activities, including, but not limited to, fully-cured asphalt, concrete, brick, rock, soil, lumber, gypsum wallboard, cardboard and other associated packaging, roofing material, ceramic tile, carpeting, fixtures, plastic pipe, metals, tree stumps, and other vegetative matter resulting from land clearing and landscaping for construction, deconstruction or land developments. This term does not include: refuse regulated under the 1932 Refuse Collection and Disposal Initiative Ordinance or sections of the Municipal Code that implements the provisions of that ordinance; materials excavated from the public right-of-way; or unless otherwise specified in Section 1402(b), materials source separated for reuse or recycling.

*Persons transporting less than one cubic yard of C&D debris or transporting C&D debris from their own site are not required to obtain a registration.*
