

1 **[Funding Recommendations for Community Grant Awards]**

3 **Resolution approving Department of the Environment Funding Recommendations for**
4 **multiple community grant awards.**

5 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, Department of the Environment
6 administers several grant programs and provides funding to non-profit groups for a wide range
7 of community projects and to promote public engagement; and,

8 WHEREAS, on August 29, 2014, the Department issued a Request for Proposals to
9 solicit proposals for community projects, including (a) Log Cabin Ranch garden and nutrition
10 project; (b) Excelsior bicycle project; and (c) Community engagement for Climate Change.
11 Based on a review and evaluation of the grant applications, the Department recommends
12 funding awards to four non-profit organizations; now, therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, the Commission approves the award of grants, totaling \$320,625 to be
14 disbursed during FY 2014-15 and FY 2015-16, to the following organizations:

15	A. Phillip Randolph Institute-San Francisco	\$ 20,000
16	The Bay Institute Aquarium Foundation	\$ 19,974
17	People Organizing to Demand Environmental & Economic Rights	\$ 70,000
18	(fiscal sponsor Tides Center)	
19	Urban Sprouts (2-year award)	\$ 210,651
20	(fiscal sponsor San Francisco Parks Alliance)
