

1 **Resolution approving Department of the Environment Funding Recommendation for**
2 **the Bayview Hunters Point Community Mural Project.**

3
4 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, Department of the Environment
5 (SF Environment) received a grant from the California Department of Resources Recycling
6 and Recovery (CalRecycle) to reduce the volume of abandoned used motor oil found in the
7 Bayview Hunters Point neighborhood and increase the community’s awareness of safe
8 disposal options by creating a community mural and conducting an education campaign; and

9 WHEREAS, SF Environment desires to work with a local organization to create a highly
10 visible mural with messaging related to the appropriate disposal of used motor oil; and

11 WHEREAS, on October 24, 2014, SF Environment issued a Request for Proposals to
12 solicit proposals for a local organization to create the mural and conduct related community
13 outreach; and

14 WHEREAS, on November 17, 2014, SF Environment received 4 proposals for the
15 community mural project and based on a review and evaluation of the applications, the
16 Department recommends awarding funding to the Bayview Opera House in the amount of
17 \$45,600; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, the Commission on the Environment approves an award in the amount of
19 \$45,600 to the Bayview Opera House for the Bayview Hunters Point Community Mural
20 Project.
