5 **RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REDUCED-RISK PESTICIDES LIST FOR SAN**
6 **FRANCISCO FOR 2005.**

8 **WHEREAS**, Section 307(d) of the San Francisco Environment Code allows the
9 Commission on the Environment to exempt “reduced-risk” pesticides from the ban imposed by
10 the Ordinance upon a finding that the “reduced-risk” pesticide is commonly used as part of an
11 IPM strategy; and,

14 **WHEREAS**, The Department of the Environment has performed an extensive
15 evaluation of pesticide products that qualify as “reduced-risk” pesticides in consultation
16 with members of the public, scientists, and departments and agencies of the City and
17 County of San Francisco; and,

20 **WHEREAS**, The Department of the Environment has developed and recommends the
21 attached revised Integrated Pest Management Program Reduced-Risk Pesticides List,
22 hereby called the Approved List 2005, for adoption by the Commission for the year 2005;

1 **WHEREAS**, The Approved List 2005 will be reviewed and updated on an as-
2 needed basis; now, therefore,

4 **BE IT RESOLVED**, That the Commission on the Environment finds that the pesticide
5 products on the Approved List 2005 are "reduced-risk" pesticides commonly used as part of
6 an IPM strategy, and are therefore exempt from the ban imposed by Sections 302 and 303 of
7 the Environment Code.
