APPROVING THE PILOT PROGRAM PLAN FOR THE ENVIRONMENTALLY PREFERABLE PURCHASING PROGRAM (EP3) AND URGING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND THE MAYOR TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PILOT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Chapter 21F of the San Francisco Administrative Code established the San Francisco Environmentally Preferable Purchasing Program (EP3) to determine the effectiveness of minimizing the City's purchase of chemicals used in janitorial services, fleet maintenance, and building maintenance and replacing them with alternatives that pose less health and environmental risks; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 21F, the Solid Waste Management Program, as Lead Department, has conducted and prepared an assessment report of current City usage and a pilot program plan with recommendations for implementation, both of which have been presented to the Commission on the Environment; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Commission on the Environment approves the Pilot Program Plan prepared by the Solid Waste Management; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission on the Environment urges the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco to adopt a resolution calling for the implementation of the Pilot Program by the Lead Department beginning in January, 2001 and ending in June, 2002.
