

1 **RESOLUTION NO. 001-004-COE**
2 **[ADOPTING REVISED REDUCED-RISK PESTICIDES LIST 2004.]**

5 **WHEREAS**, Section 307(d) of the San Francisco Environment Code allows the Commission on the
6 Environment to exempt “reduced-risk” pesticides from the ban imposed by the Ordinance upon a
7 finding that the “reduced-risk” pesticide is commonly used as part of an IPM strategy; and,

8
9 **WHEREAS**, The Department of the Environment has performed an extensive evaluation of pesticide
10 products that qualify as “reduced-risk” pesticides in consultation with members of the public, scientists,
11 and departments and agencies of the City and County of San Francisco; and,

12
13 **WHEREAS**, The Department of the Environment has developed and recommends the attached revised
14 Integrated Pest Management Program Reduced-Risk Pesticides List, hereby called the List 2004, for
15 adoption by the Commission for the year 2004; and,

16
17 **WHEREAS**, The List 2004 will be reviewed and updated on an as-needed basis; now, therefore,

18
19 **BE IT RESOLVED**, That the Commission on the Environment finds that the pesticide products on the
20 List 2004 are “reduced-risk” pesticides commonly used as part of an IPM strategy, and are therefore
21 exempt from the ban imposed by Sections 302 and 303 of the Environment Code.
