3 **Resolution adopting Revised Reduced-Risk Pesticides List for 2006.**

5 WHEREAS, Section 307(d) of the San Francisco Environment Code allows the
6 Commission on the Environment to exempt “reduced-risk” pesticides from the ban imposed by
7 the Ordinance upon a finding that the “reduced-risk” pesticide is commonly used as part of an
8 IPM strategy; and,

9 WHEREAS, The Department of the Environment has performed an extensive
10 evaluation of pesticide products that qualify as “reduced-risk” pesticides in consultation with
11 members of the public, scientists, and departments and agencies of the City and County of
12 San Francisco; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Department of the Environment has developed and recommends the
14 attached revised Integrated Pest Management Program Reduced-Risk Pesticides List, hereby
15 called the Approved List 2006, for adoption by the Commission for the year 2006; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Approved List 2006 will be reviewed and updated on an as-needed
17 basis; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Commission on the Environment finds that the pesticide
19 products on the Approved List 2006 are “reduced-risk” pesticides commonly used as part of
20 an IPM strategy, and are therefore exempt from the ban imposed by Sections 302 and 303 of
21 the Environment Code.
