

1 [Resolution endorsing tree for landmark tree status-2830 25<sup>th</sup> Street]

3 WHEREAS, Public Works Code, Article 16, Section 810 charges the Urban  
4 Forestry Council to examine nominated landmark trees using criteria approved by the  
5 Board of Supervisors; and,

6 WHEREAS, the Valley Oak (*Quercus lobata*) tree at 2830 25<sup>th</sup> Street fullfills the  
7 following subjective and objective criteria developed by the Urban Forestry Council that  
8 includes:

- 9 Rare species in San Francisco
- 10 Greater than typical mature size or age of 200 years
- 11 Neighborhood appreciation of tree
- 12 Adds tremendously to the neighborhood character
- 13 Extends between several properties and enjoyed by many people
- 14 Visually accessible from public right-of-way
- 15 Important wildlife habitat
- 16 Prominent landscape feature

19 WHEREAS, this tree provides social, environmental and economic benefits to the  
20 property, neighborhood and city; now, therefore be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Urban Forestry Council recommends this tree for landmark  
22 status to the Board of Supervisors.
